Hite Elementary serves 520 PreK – 5th grade students and provides technology access for 64 staff members. Hite Elementary follows the Program of Studies, KCAS Standards, and Computer Application Skills Continuum.

Technology Mission Statement

The mission of Hite Elementary is to develop, implement, and embrace a comprehensive school technology plan that will challenge all and improve academic performance for all members of the Hite learning community.

Teachers

All staff will adhere to the Acceptable Use Policy. All staff will use district issued laptops on a daily basis to impart knowledge as outlined in district curriculum guidelines. Teachers will have opportunities to attend on-going technology-based PD's online or in a classroom setting. All staff will apply knowledge of the teacher standards for technology. Smartboards and other technology tools will be utilized for instruction. Webpages will be used for regular communication and as a support system for families.

Students

All students will adhere to the Acceptable Use Policy. Students will participate in learning the contents of the Computer Applications Skills Continuum. All students will demonstrate safe internet use skills. It is the goal of the school for all students to reach scores of 90% or higher on the CASA test.
